## **Materials for 12" block**

(12½" unfinished)

- Light fabrics for background
- Star fabric

## **Cutting**

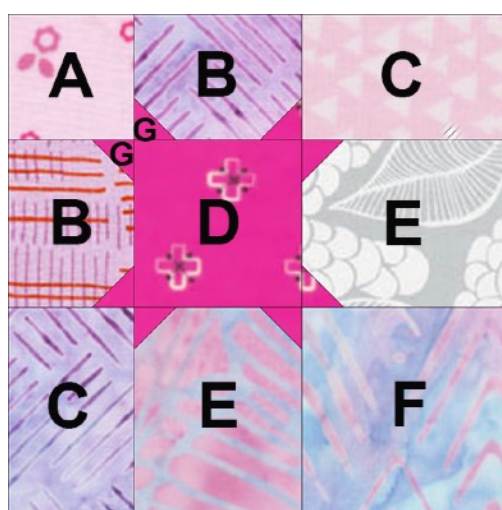
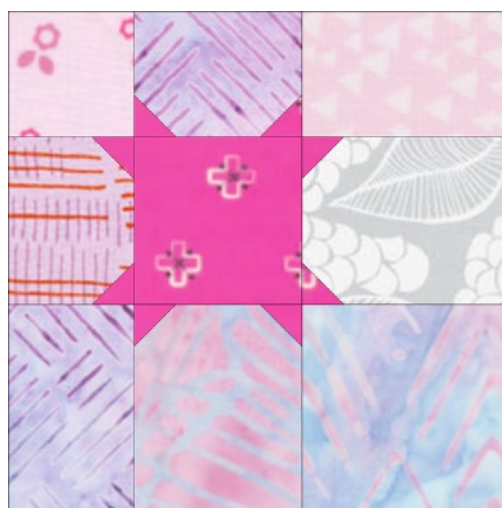
### **Lights**

1 square A 3-1/2" x 3-1/2"  
1 square F 5-1/2" x 5-1/2"

2 rectangles B 3-1/2" x 4-1/2"  
2 rectangles C 3-1/2" x 5-1/2"  
2 rectangles E 4-1/2" x 5-1/2"

### **Star**

1 square D 4-1/2" x 4-1/2"



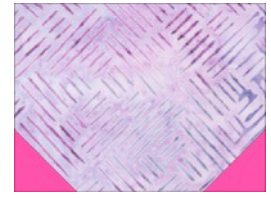
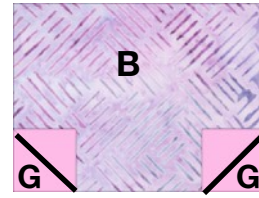

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## Sewing

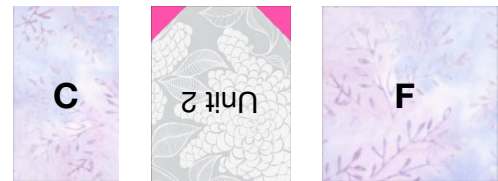
1. General instructions: You'll use stitch-and-flip to create the star points. Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of all the G squares. You'll place the squares on the rectangles as indicated for each unit, right sides together. Then you'll sew on the marked line, trim the seam allowance to  $\frac{1}{4}$ ", flip the G patch open and press.
2. Align a star-fabric G square on each bottom corner of a light B rectangle as shown, paying attention to the orientation of the drawn lines. Sew on the lines, trim, flip open and press to complete unit 1. Repeat with the other B rectangle and 2 G's. Make 2 unit 1's.
3. Align a star-fabric G square on each bottom corner of a light E rectangle as shown, paying attention to the orientation of the drawn lines. Sew on the lines, trim, flip open and press to complete unit 2. Repeat with the other E rectangle and 2 G's. Make 2 unit 2's.
4. Arrange the patches as shown to the right, rotating the units as needed to form the star.
5. Join the patches and units to make the top, middle and bottom rows as shown below. Press the seams in the top and bottom rows outward. Press the seams in the middle row inward.
6. Sew the rows together.



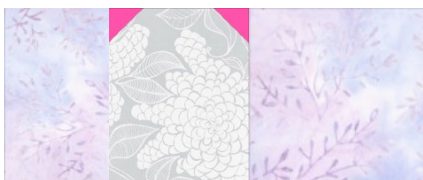
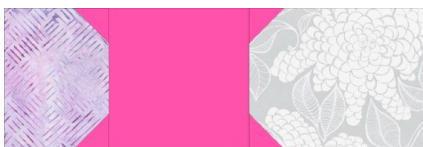
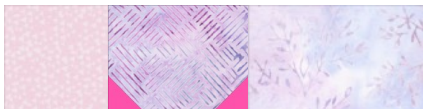
Unit 1, make 2
